Admission Requirements (Undergraduate Programs)

BBA, B.Sc (Hons.) in CSE, LL. B (Hons.), B.A (Hons.) in English.

A candidate must have minimum GPA 2.5 in both SSC and HSC or in equivalent examinations or GPA 6.00 (combined) but score not less than GPA 2.00 in any individual examination.

In case of Freedom Fighter wards, a candidate should have minimum GPA 5.00 (combined) but score not less than GPA 2.00 in any individual examination.

O/A Level students must have minimum 5 subjects in O-level and 2 subjects in A-level with GPA 4.00 in 4 subjects and GPA 3.5 in 3 subjects.

B.Pharm (Hons.)

A candidate must have minimum aggregate GPA 6.50 in SSC and HSC (Combined) but score not less than 3.00 in each examination (without optional) and also **as per guideline of Bangladesh Pharmacy Council.**

Admission Requirements (Graduate Programs)

MBA (for BBA Graduates):

A candidate must have minimum GPA 2.5 in both SSC and HSC or in equivalent examinations or GPA 6.00 (combined) but score not less than GPA 2.00 in any individual examination and must have minimum CGPA 2.0 in BBA Program.

MBA:

A candidate must have graduation from any discipline with minimum CGPA 2.0 with 2.50 (Minimum) in both SSC & HSC examinations.

MBA (Executive):

A candidate must have graduation from any discipline with minimum CGPA 2.0 with 2.50 (Minimum) in both SSC & HSC examinations and 2 years working experience.

MA in English:

A candidate must have minimum GPA 2.5 in both SSC and HSC or in equivalent examinations or GPA 6.00 (combined) but score not less than GPA 2.00 in any individual examination and must have minimum CGPA 2.0 in BA (Hons.) in English.

Application Procedure

A candidate should apply in the prescribed application form available at BGC Trust University Bangladesh information desk on payment of Tk. 300 (Three hundred). The application form is to be duly filled in and submitted with all academic certificates and transcripts/Mark sheets and four passport size photographs to the admission office within the deadline of submission. It is to be noted that incomplete application will not be considered for admission.

Code of Conduct for Students

1. Wearing ID Card is mandatory inside the campus.
1. Consumption of tobacco products, alcohol, drugs or illegal materials are strictly prohibited inside the University premises.
2. No political discussion in any form is allowed.
3. Students will have to wear decent dress.
4. Students will have to remain present during the observance of all National Programs and others arranged by the University authority.
5. Students have liberty to arrange extra-curricular activities with due permission from the University authority.
6. Students are allowed to place their genuine grievance (if any) to the proper authority in a peaceful manner.
7. Chanting of slogans in any form is prohibited.
8. Dis-collegiate students are not allowed to sit for the examinations.
9. Students shall have to pay tuition and other fees regularly.
10. Cyber crime in the form of web portal, social media, blogs, e-mail, phones etc. are strictly prohibited.
11. Use, sale, possession of drug in any form is forbidden.
12. Use or carrying weapons inside the campus is strictly prohibited.
13. Ragging and bullying in any form is forbidden in the campus of the university.

IQAC

As a part of quality education in Bangladesh, the UGC has undertaken World Bank Credit Scheme on Higher Education, HEQEP to strengthen overall quality education in both private and public institutions. IQAC is the outcome of such a program.

Following the Private University Act, 2010 BGCTUB has a Integrated Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) since 2016. It's involved in assuring quality education, roles and responsibilities of ethical principles of the university teachers through peer review and self-assessment.

Research

To promote research activities, BGCTUB has a research cell. Grants are provided to the teachers who present papers at home and abroad. Research grants are also provided to the teachers who are enrolled in PhD program each year. Every year BGC Trust University Journal is published. The authority also encourages the acquisition of higher degree by the faculty members.

Automation

Integrated University Management Software (IUMS) is operating at our university. This is a automated system for students to have their results, know about tuition fees and other related academic affairs.

Health Care Facilities

A modernized 500 bed hospital is situated at BGC Bidyanagar. All employees and students of the university and other institutions are getting health care services through health card. With minimum cost, Ibrahim Iqbal Memorial Hospital provides health care services for 24 hours.

Library Facilities

BGCTUB has a library enriched with text books, e-journal, journal and periodicals. Moreover, it subscribes to the UGC Digital Library (UDL). Students and teachers may access it through software.

Academic Calendar

Academic Calendar is strictly followed in all programs. The students are informed about the academic calendar at the very outset of each semester.

Course Evaluation System

BGC Trust University Bangladesh follows most modern model of higher education consisting of semesters, courses, credit hours, evaluation and letter grading. Students' performance is evaluated throughout the semester through class tests, quizzes, workshops, case presentation, assignments, term paper, mid term and final exam.

Co-curricular and Extra-Curricular Activities

- BGCTUB provides the students with the right balance of academic attainment with scopes for co-curricular activities necessary for their mental development.
- BGC Trust University Bangladesh observes all national days and festivals including Bangla Nabo Barsha, Independence Day, Victory Day, International Mother Language Day, Eid-e-Miladunnabi, Bani Archana etc. There are also ample facilities for indoor games. Arrangements are made for outdoor sports as well. Students are also encouraged to organize different creative activities, group projects/ professional clubs and cultural activities. The university has two centrally managed clubs, i.e. BGCTUB Debating Society and BGCTUB Cultural Club. The other days and festivals organized by the departments are Constitution Day, Human Rights Day, World Pharmacists Day and Shakespears Birth Anniversary etc.

There is a Moot court and a good collection of reading materials (both Books and Journals) in the Law Section of the Library. An Overview of the Department of English

The Department of English, BGC Trust University Bangladesh offers a four year Bachelor of Arts (Honours) Program and one year MA in English program in Language and Literature. The syllabus of BA (Honours) aims to make the learners aware of English Language, Literature, History and classical and current worldviews and thus enables them to successfully grapple with the modern-day world as competent graduates. This university is situated in the very heart of rural life with a commitment to provide higher education for underprivileged students. Since most of them have a weak foundation of English, in the early part of their undergraduate program a greater emphasis is given on their grooming up to the expected level so that they can acquire a hands-on working knowledge of English, learning it in the modern task-based approach.

Similarly, the syllabus of MA in English Language and Literature has been designed to produce efficient graduates with the knowledge of seminal works of major writers of English Literature and modern theories of English Language Teaching. So, emphasis has been given on blending courses on English Literature, Linguistics and Language Teaching to meet the burgeoning demand of job market.

To become one of the leading English departments in the country by widening students' horizon of knowledge and by inculcating the 21st century graduate skills through interdisciplinary and practical approaches.
